

**TOWN OF WILKESBORO
APPLICATION FOR DEMONSTRATIONS PERMIT
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 92 OF THE WILKESBORO TOWN CODE**

APPLICATION

1. The application herein in accordance with Section 92.3 of the Wilkesboro Town Code applies for a permit in conduct or participate in a parade or picket line or group demonstration in or upon any street, sidewalk, or other public place within the Town of Wilkesboro as follows:

(a) The persons or persons to be in charge of the parade, picket line or group demonstration (strike inapplicable activities) on any street, sidewalk, or other public place (strike any inapplicable area) shall be _____, and the address and telephone number of said group is as follows:

(b) That minors below the age of eighteen (18) years will be/will not be (strike the inapplicable activity) permitted to participate in the activity.

(c) That the person in charge of the activity, _____, as listed above will accompany the parade, picket line, or group demonstration (strike inapplicable activity), of _____ (name of group) and shall carry such permit with him/her at that time. Such permit shall not be valid in the possession of any other person other than _____, the person in charge.

(d) The starting time for said activity will be _____ o' clock, _____ M. on the _____ day of _____, 20_____. The ending time for said activity will be _____ o'clock, _____, M, on the _____ day of _____, 20_____.

(e) The duration of said activity will be as follows:

(g) The speed of travel of such activity will be as follows: _____

(h) The space between persons or vehicles in the parade, picket line, or group demonstration (strike inapplicable) is estimated to be as follows:

(i) The portion of areas of streets, sidewalks, or other public places to be used will be:

(j) The undersigned hereby represents that the above-listed activity shall not infringe upon the free movement of pedestrian or vehicular traffic or the health, safety and property rights of the participants or the general public. The undersigned do hereby represent to the Town of Wilkesboro that the above proposed activity would not constitute a clear and present danger to the public health or safety or hinder the orderly movement of pedestrian or vehicular traffic on the streets, sidewalks, or public places in the Town of Wilkesboro.

(k) The undersigned further represent to the Town of Wilkesboro that no one involved in the herein requested activity will carry any firearm or weapon including but not limited to blackjacks, nightsticks, flashlights or any other article which might constitute a deadly weapon, nor take or keep any dog or vicious animal whether leased or unleashed during said activity or carry or display any flag or emblem of any foreign state or any foreign political party or other organization which is engaged in hostilities against the armed forces of the United States. The undersigned represent to the Town of Wilkesboro that this permit is applied for at least twenty four (24) hours before the activity as requested in this permit is to begin.

(l) The undersigned further represent to the Town of Wilkesboro that the activity sought to be performed in this permit will not interfere with the right of property owners in the area to enjoy peaceful and lawful occupancy and their use of their property.

(m) The undersigned understands that the following conditions apply to picketing: (1) picketing may be conducted only on the sidewalks reserved for pedestrian movement and may not be conducted on any portion of a street used primarily for vehicular traffic; (2) not more than ten (10) pickets promoting the same objective shall be permitted to use either of the two sidewalks within a single block at any one time; (3) pickets may carry written or printed signs not exceeding two (2) feet in width by two (2) feet in length promoting the objective of the picket, however the words cannot be derogatory or defamatory or profane in nature; (4) pickets must march in single file, not abreast and not closer together than fifteen (15) feet except in passing one another; (5) pickets will not be allowed to walk more than five (5) feet from the curb line

and shall be in continuous motion; (6) if pickets promoting different objectives desire to use the same sidewalks for picketing and such would result in the presence of more than ten (10) pickets thereon, the Chief of Police shall allot time to each group of pickets for the use of such sidewalk on an equitable basis.
