# Our Curbside Recycling Program

## Acceptable Curbside Materials

### Rollout Recycling Bin - Town Owned

- \* Newspapers
- \* Magazines, Phonebooks & Junk Mail
- \* Aluminum Cans, foil, & pans (rinsed)
- \* Metals Food Cans (rinsed)
- \* Plastic Bottles and Beverage Jugs (anything with a cap)
- \* Corrugated Cardboard Boxes (must be broken down flat)
- \* Pasteboard Boxes (cereal, crackers, paper rolls)

### 2nd Small Container - Privately Owned

- \* Glass Bottles & Jars

## Non Acceptable Materials

- \* Margarine Containers
- \* Yogurt Cups
- \* Frozen Food Trays
- \* Six Pack Rings
- \* Plastic Wrap
- \* Plastic Bags
- \* Plastic Packaging
- \* Plastic Bottles that contained hazardous substances or motor oil
- \* Wax Coated Pasteboard/Cardboard
- \* Pizza or Greasy Boxes
- \* Styrofoam of any form - egg cartons, packing peanuts, to-go boxes, plates, etc.



**Bi-weekly curbside recycling collection** will be provided by the Town and is on a **different day** as your scheduled trash pickup.

**Schedules** are online at [www.wilkesboronc.org](http://www.wilkesboronc.org) or Town Hall. Schedules are mailed once each year with the water bills as well.

Public Works distributes **one** 65 gallon rollout recycling bin to each garbage customer and the fee is \$8.00/mo. If you would like to have another rollout bin, you will need to make a \$50.00 **deposit** per rollout bin and pay the **extra monthly fee** for residential. \$8.00/bin & Commercial \$15.00/bin.

### GLASS MUST BE SEPARATED IN A SECOND CONTAINER

from other recyclables due to the automatic arm used to pick up the bins and dump into the truck.

Approved containers for glass are available for purchase at the Wilkesboro Town Hall for \$15.00 each or you may purchased your own container.

Please be sure to write “**GLASS RECYCLING**” on your purchased container.

The recycling containers shall be placed curbside on your scheduled recycling day without blocking sidewalks or mailboxes.

Bin may be placed curbside after 7:00 pm the night before and **must be removed** by 7:00 pm on the day of pickup.

Cart users are responsible for keeping their containers clean and in good repair. If you need a repair, contact Public Works Dept. 838-0188.



**NOTICE: Please do NOT bag your recyclable items in town bins.**  
If bagged, your recycling cannot be picked up until unbagged per the Town's vendor.
